Newswire—now viewed by over 1000 people a day on average, nearing half-a-million visits since it began only two years ago.

What helps us *most* in our work to produce and circulate EF! news is to see new groups forming and an increase in direct actions occurring worldwide. Next to that is help with funds to keep the *Journal* office afloat.

Even with our exhaustive efforts, we must apologize to our subscribers, as we are still an issue behind schedule on our printed edition. The newest issue is completed and will be mailed out shortly, but first we need a little help from our friends! (That's you.) Rest assured, as we've said before, we intend to keep pumping out news, analysis and strategy from the eco-wars 'till the bitter end!

Over the last six months we've gained two new long-term collective members-one specializing in layout and design, the other a former longtermer who has returned to focus on the business. As a result, we are in the midst of increasing our promotion and distribution efforts, along with new merchandise and more tabling/outreach endeavors. With five people on the collective once again, after a long spell of being short-handed, we are excited to see new Earth First! Journals rolling out (on time) and new funding rolling in!

We've also been able to double the number of prisoners who receive the EF! Journal since last year, thanks to an increase of gift subscriptions.
